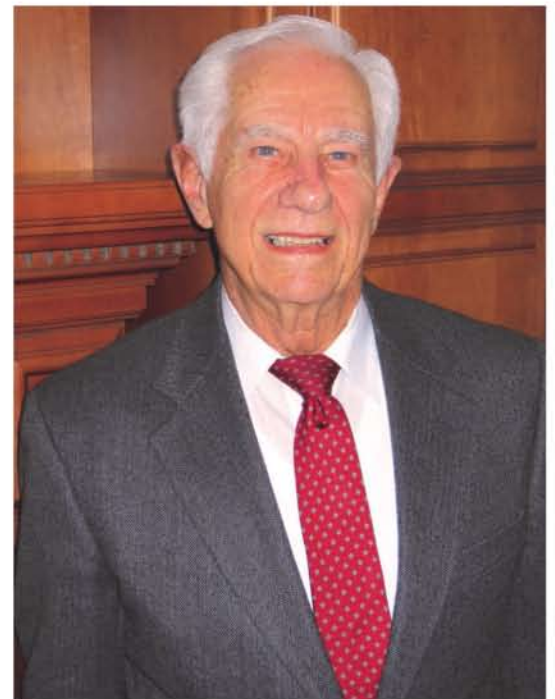

## Cabinets Plus' "New Woods 'n Cabinetry"

We now carry **Omega/Dynasty Cabinetry** in addition to **Mouser Custom Cabinetry** and **Medallion Cabinetry**. These three lines combined offer hundreds of design ideas for kitchens, baths and other rooms. The most popular wood species sold today are still Cherry and Maple. Both have even grains and colors ranging from light to dark. Lately, Alder and Quarter sawn Oak have emerged as trend setters...let's talk about these "new woods".

**Alder** is a medium density hardwood that features a fairly uniform color and a close grain. Knotty, which is sometimes called "Rustic Alder", is characterized by large knots. It's a less formal wood and is commonly mistaken for pine. When cabinet companies take the time to choose the wood carefully to eliminate large knots, alder will take on the appearance of cherry (but without the higher cost). You'll find this wood categorized as select or clear. Alder takes most finish colors well. In lighter colors it tends not to darken as much as cherry. Using mid to dark tone stains will not mottle or make the wood look blotchy in appearance.

**Quarter sawn Oak** is most commonly associated with the Mission or Craftsman style furniture where the style itself is simple in order to allow the beauty of the wood to be the ornamentation. Quarter sawn Oak gets its name from how the log was oriented when the lumber was sawn. This method of cutting reveals a much straighter grain than traditional oak. Colors range from a nearly white sapwood to a darker gray-brown heartwood. This hardwood will take stain evenly and quarter sawn oak is known for its strength, durability and beauty.
